The Town of Dune Acres Town Council conducted a Public Hearing on Tuesday, January 21, 2020, at the Town Hall. Council President Rich Hawksworth opened the hearing at 7:00 p.m., with Council Members Alexander Stemer, Clerk-Treasurer Jeannette Bapst, and Attorney Adam Mindel representing Dan Whitten in attendance.

**PUBLIC INPUT ON NEW CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND TAX RATE**

The Town Council had advertised the “Notice to Taxpayers of Hearing on Proposed Cumulative Capital Development Fund” tax rate. The notice was published in *The Times* and *Chesterton Tribune* on January 2, 2020 and January 9, 2020. It was posted on the town website, and posted in four locations in town.

The Town Council is proposing a CCD rate .0350 per \$100 assessed valuation.

Approximately 8 residents attended the hearing. One resident spoke in opposition to the increase.
