

**TOWN OF DUNE ACRES

CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT (CCD) FUND TAX RATE
January 11, 2022**

The Town of Dune Acres Town Council conducted a Public Hearing on Tuesday, January 11, 2022, via zoom teleconference. Council President Rich Hawksworth opened the hearing at 7:00 p.m., with Council Members Alexander Stemer and Paul Woidke, Clerk-Treasurer Jeannette Bapst, and Attorney Adam Mindel in attendance.

PUBLIC INPUT ON NEW CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND TAX RATE

The Town Council had advertised the “Notice to Taxpayers of Hearing on Proposed Cumulative Capital Development Fund” tax rate. The notice was published in *The Times* and *Chesterton Tribune* on December 30, 2021 and January 6, 2022. It was posted on the town website, and posted in town.

The Town Council is proposing a CCD rate .0370 per \$100 assessed valuation for taxes payable in 2023.

Approximately 6 residents attended the hearing. No residents spoke in opposition to the increase.
