The Town of Dune Acres Town Council met for its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 18, 2024, at the Clubhouse. COMMISSIONERS REPORTS:

BEACH: None

BUILDING: Four projects were presented:

Building Permit 2024-13, 75 East Building Permit 2024-14, 4 Shore Building Permit 2024-15, 44 Circle Building Permit 2024-16, 70 West

It was moved and seconded to approve all four projects, with 2024-13 contingent on a preliminary review by the Plan Commission to evaluate whether a full review is necessary. The motion passed unanimously.

ENVIRONMENT: None

FIRE: None

MAINTENANCE: Ridge stairs have been completed; Shore is underway.

PARKS: Perm-A-Seal was asked to fix sub-par work. Commissioner Shawn Fitzpatrick will investigate night lighting for the back pickleball court.

ROADS: Paving work has been completed, with the exception of a few areas needing additional attention.

SECURITY: Another new hire was presented by Security Commissioner Lee McKinley. It was moved and seconded to move forward with the hire. The vote was unanimous in favor; motion passed. New, larger signs will be designed and installed to deter beach visitors from driving down Mineral Springs Road.

OLD BUSINESS:

Tom Roberts provided an overview of our Trust Indiana investment fund.

NEW BUSINESS:

Clubhouse rentals were presented for 07-09-24; 08/08/24; and 08/16/24. It was motioned and seconded to approve all three rentals. The motion carried unanimously.

Opioid remediation funds must be directed toward activities such as expanding training for first responders, schools, community support groups, etc. and providing education to school-based and youth-focused programs that discourage or prevent misuse. Duneland School Corporation has submitted a proposal for how the Town might support their Drug Awareness Program. It was moved and seconded to approve the donation in support of this project. The motion passed unanimously.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:55 PM.
